Pathogen	Application Rate	Use Instructions
Botrytis Leaf Blight (<i>Botrytis</i> <i>squamosa</i>)	Apply at a concentration of 4.5 ounces (128 grams) per 100 gallons of water	Begin as a preventative spray. Repeat every 7-14 days as part of a rotational program with fungicides labelled for this use.

Crop-Specific Restrictions:

Do not apply directly to water or to areas where surface water is present, or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters or rinsate. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift or runoff from treated areas.

Do not allow the mixture to stand overnight in the spray tank.
